Tucson Scholastics (South Regional Qualifier #2) March 27, 2010

Location: Harelson Elementary, 826 W Chapala Dr., Tucson, AZ 85704. <u>From East and South:</u> Take Oracle to Ina Rd. Turn west on Ina and go 1 block to Paseo Del Norte. Turn north unto Paseo Del Norte and go approximately ½ miles to Chapala Dr and turn east. The school is located on the northwest corner. <u>From West or I-10</u>: Take I-10 to Ina Rd (Exit 248). Take Ina east about 5 miles to Paseo Del Norte. Follow above directions to the school.

Description: USCF rated. Open to students in grades K-12. The qualifier sections are 5 games with a time control of Game in 40. The championship sections are 4 games with a time control of Game in 60. Bring chess clocks and sets, none provided.

- **USCF Info. USCF Membership is required for all sections.** USCF membership can be purchased or renewed online at the <u>USCF website</u>. You'll need your USCF ID when you register. <u>Contact us</u> if you need any help with obtaining this information.
- **To Register:** Entry fee is \$15 per player. All registration (and payment) is to be done either online at the <u>SACA</u> <u>Store</u> or through the mail. Mail registrations must be postmarked by Wednesday, March 24. Online registration will close at 8:00 PM on Friday, March 26. No at site or phone entries will be accepted!

AZ State Scholastic Championship April 23-25, 2010 Holiday Inn, Palo Verde

Qualifications: To play in the AZ State Scholastic Championships, a player must qualify a "slot" at a Regional Qualifier. A school may bring the number of players equal to the number of slots qualified at all Regional Qualifiers +1; a team qualifying exactly two slots in a section may bring four players in that section. Players qualify slots by: K-1 section: play at least 4 rounds OR score 3 points; Primary K-3, Elementary K-6, and Junior High K-9: score at least 3 points at a qualifier; High School Grades 9-12: do not have to qualify. A player may not qualify more than one slot, regardless of the number of qualifiers played.
